**Juneau Chapter Executive Board Elections**

The ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 Juneau Chapter is soliciting nominations from members in good standing for the Juneau Chapter Executive Board offices of Treasurer, Secretary, President and one (1) Member at-Large. Terms of office for all positions are from October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2012.

Any member in good standing who desires to serve in one of the above capacities for the full term of office should submit the required candidate nomination form to Shareef Siddeek, Election Committee Chair, ASEA Local 52 Juneau Chapter, P.O. Box 20009, Juneau, AK 99802. An optional maximum one-page candidate campaign statement may also be submitted in the required format. Nominations and optional campaign statements must be received at the Chapter P.O. Box by 5:00 p.m. Friday, August 20, 2010 (Close of Nominations Date). Faxed or e-mailed nominations or optional candidate statements will not be accepted. ASEA Local 52 Headquarters will certify candidates in good standing following the close of nominations. Elections will not be held for unopposed candidates.

The required candidate nomination and optional candidate statement forms may be accessed at <http://www.aseajuneau.org> under the link Election Notices. If you are unable to access them from the Chapter website, you may request mailed hard copies by leaving your name and mailing address in a voice message for the Election Committee at (907) 463-4609. Voice mail is checked daily and requested forms will be mailed immediately.

An election for each available Executive Board seat will be held on Wednesday, September 1, 2010 (Election Date) during the hours of 7:00-9:00 a.m., 12:00-1:00 p.m., and 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Local 959 Teamsters Hall at 306 Willoughby Avenue. At least one Election Committee member will be present at the polling site during these hours. The Election Committee will provide equal access viewing of all optional campaign statements submitted by the close of nominations to voting members at the polling place on election day.

Voting members will be required to provide current photo identification at the polling site to verify member in good standing status from a member checklist provided by ASEA Local 52 Headquarters. Following the close of polls at 6:00 p.m., ballots will be counted by the Election Committee and an election report posted to the Chapter website shortly thereafter.

A run-off election if necessary will be held on Friday, September 10, 2010 (Run-off Election Date) during the hours of 7:00-9:00 a.m., 12:00-1:00 p.m., and 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Local 959 Teamsters Hall at 306 Willoughby Ave. At least one Election Committee member will be present at the polling site during these hours. The Election Committee will provide equal access viewing of all original optional campaign statements submitted by the close of nominations on August 20, 2010 to voting members at the polling place on election day. Following the close of polls at 6:00 p.m., ballots will be counted by the Election Committee and an election report posted to the Chapter website shortly thereafter.

Each candidate has the right to have one observer of his/her choice present for the counting of the ballots at the Local 959 Teamsters Hall following close of polls at 6:00 p.m. on September 1, 2010 and if necessary at 6:00 p.m. on September 10, 2010.

All duly elected officers of the Chapter Executive Board will be installed into office by the Election Committee at a general membership meeting on Tuesday, September 28, 2010 12:05-12:55 p.m. at the Local 959 Teamsters Hall.
