## **NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION DATE**

### **ASEA/AFSCME LOCAL 52 JUNEAU CHAPTER 2012 STATEWIDE BIENNIAL CONVENTION DELEGATE**

**November 9, 2011**

The 14<sup>th</sup> Biennial Convention of ASEA/AFSCME Local 52, AFL-CIO, will be held at the Hotel Captain Cook at 939 West Fifth Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska on Thursday through Sunday, March 15-18, 2012.

The Juneau Chapter was represented by 17 primary delegates at the last Biennial Convention in 2010. The final calculation of the number of delegates to the 2012 Biennial Convention which Juneau is entitled to will not be announced until the Call to Convention in December. The Chapter will tentatively elect 17 primary delegates for the 2012 Convention, the final number of delegates to be announced by ASEA Local 52 Headquarters.

Nomination petitions for 2012 convention delegate must be received at the Chapter mailing address by the close of nominations at 5:00 p.m. Friday, December 9, 2011. Nominees may also provide an optional candidate campaign statement (maximum one single-sided 8 ½ by 11 in. page) by the same deadline, to be provided by the Election Committee to voting members for review at the polling place on election day.

Incomplete nomination forms will not be certified.

Faxes or e-mails are not acceptable.

Convention primary and alternate delegates will be determined by certified nominations and subsequent vote of Juneau Chapter members on the Election Date of Tuesday, December 13, 2011 between 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Noon to 1:00 p.m., and 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Teamsters Hall Local 959 at 306 Willoughby Avenue, Juneau, Alaska.

Any Juneau member in good standing may be nominated. Juneau Chapter policy per vote of the Chapter Executive Board is you must be willing to certify in advance on the nomination petition that the delegate will be present at the Convention and at all Committee Work Sessions to which the delegate is assigned during the entire four (4) day period Thursday through Sunday, March 15-18, 2012. The appropriate boxes on the nomination petition must be checked yes or no. Absent such certification your nomination will not be certified by the Election Committee.

ASEA Local 52 Headquarters will confirm nominees in good standing and the Chapter Election Committee will certify nominations received by close of nominations on December 9, 2011.

In order to vote in the election, you must be a Juneau member in good standing and bring photo identification to the Teamsters Hall polling place on December 13, 2011 during the above specified hours for verification on a master member list provided by ASEA Headquarters.

Following the close of polls at 6:00 p.m. on December 13, the Election Committee will count the ballots. Each candidate has the right to have one observer who is a member in good standing present for the counting of ballots. Primary and alternate delegates will be determined in the order of highest to lowest vote getter. Following the certification of election results by the Election Committee, the date of conclusion for the 10-day period of election protest specified in the AFSCME Constitution will be December 23, 2011.

If there are 17 or fewer certified nominations, the Election Committee will declare them all duly elected and no election will be held. Vacant seats may subsequently be appointed by vote of the Juneau Chapter Executive Board.

All primary convention delegate travel expenses including airfare, hotel, taxi to and from the airport, and per diem are to be paid for by ASEA/AFSCME Local 52. ASEA Local 52 Business Leave will also be provided for days absent from the workplace.
