ELECTION COMMITTEE REPORT TO THE CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD

Notice of Nominations and Election for the 2012 ASEA/AFSCME Local 52 Biennial Convention Juneau Chapter delegates was mailed to the Chapter membership on November 9, 2011 in accordance with current Chapter Bylaws and AFSCME Election Code requirements. Nominations closed at 5:00 p.m., 9 December, 2011. Twelve (12) complete nominations were received for the eighteen (18) Juneau Chapter Delegate positions. The twelve (12) members who submitted nomination materials by the deadline and were certified to be in good standing by ASEA Local 52 Headquarters were declared duly elected. One of these elected delegates died on December 18, 2011.

The nominations for the remaining seven (7) candidates were solicited from the chapter members through an email message and the nominations closed at 5:00 p.m., January 6, 2012. Nine complete nominations were received for the seven (7) remaining Delegate positions. An election was held on January 10, 2012 by the Executive Board and following certified members were elected to the first six (6) vacant delegate positions:
